Phase 5 Renovation Project Budget Models

Financing Options

Dr. Hang reviewed several financing options for the proposed phase 5 project:

- Traditional bonding with the city of St. Paul HRA office
- Bank qualified loan
- Equitable facilities funds

Ms. Christy Yong Vang motioned to move forward to secure funding in the amount of up to 21 million dollars for the phase 5 project. The motion was seconded by Mr. Vue Thaow. The motion carried.
