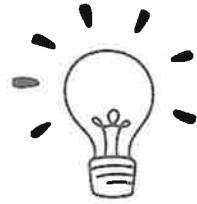


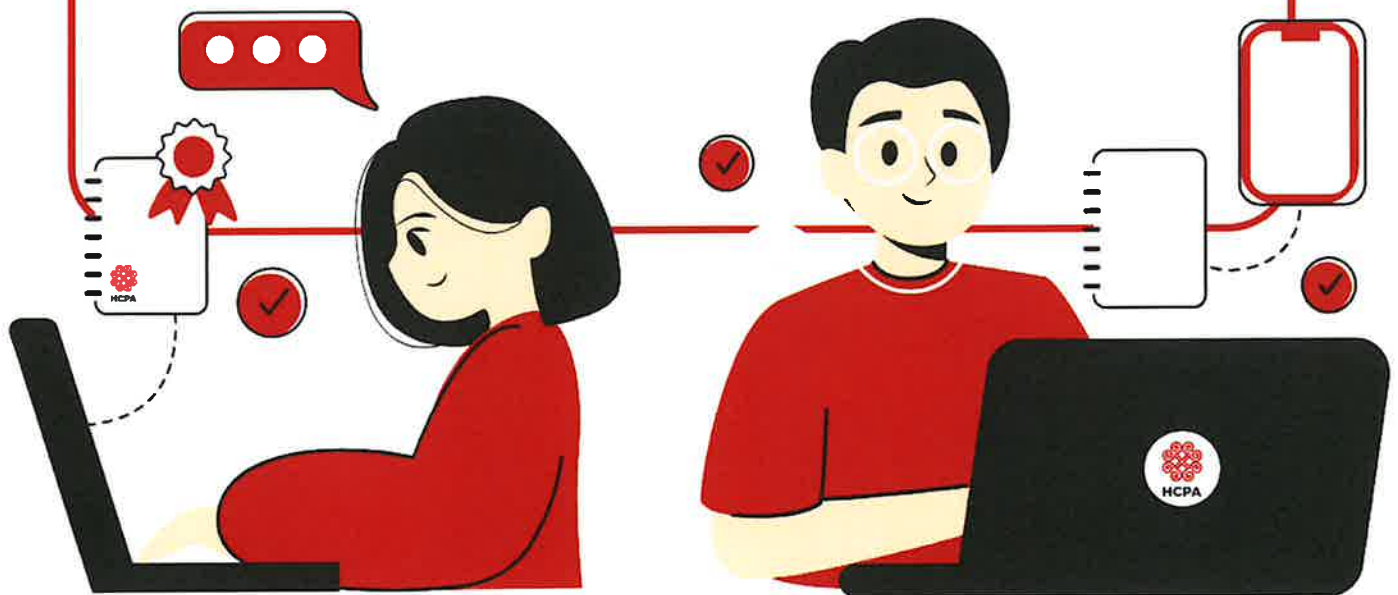

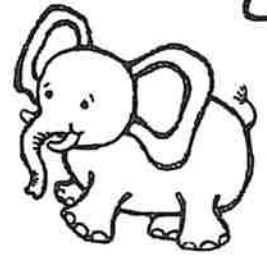

Elephants



Elephants are the largest land mammals on Earth. Their long ears help keep them cool. Elephants have long front teeth called tusks. They use their tusks to dig for and collect food. They also have a long nose called a trunk. Elephants use their trunks to make sounds, touch and grab food. They eat for up to 22 hours a day! Elephants eat grass roots and fruits. To stay clean, elephants use their trunks to spray water on themselves. Elephants are found in Africa and Asia and they can live to be 70 years old.

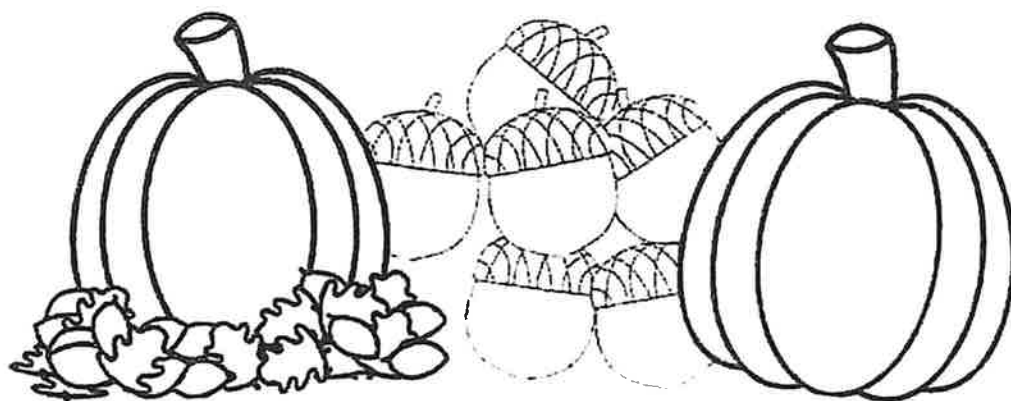

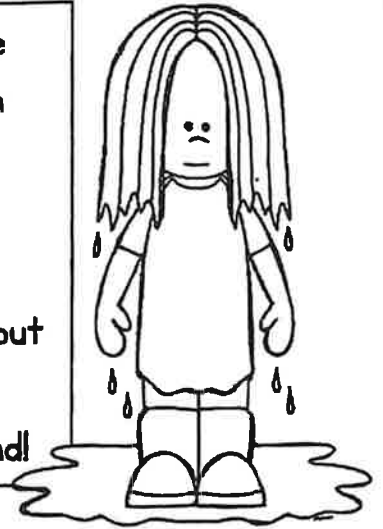

Tigers are the largest wild cat in the world. They are very strong and powerful. A tiger's roar is very loud and can be heard up to two miles away! Tigers live and hunt alone. OWLS

Owls are birds that live in most places of the world. They have large, round heads and huge eyes. Most owls are nocturnal, so their large eyes are helpful when hunting at night. Their fluffy feathers allow them to quietly sneak up on their prey. Owls have short hooked beaks and sharp claws to help grab their prey. Rodents, insects, frogs and other birds are what owls hunt for. Owls eat the whole animal since they do not have teeth. They then spit up the inedible parts such as hair, bones, and teeth.
