After School Program Rules and Regulations

All Rules and Regulations located in the HCPA Student Handbook apply to the After School Program. Below are some additional rules that also apply along with some reminders.

- 1. Class disturbances will not be tolerated. If students are dismissed from class for inappropriate behaviors, it will count as an absence.
- 2. Students absent for more than 5 days in a row will be removed from the program without prior notification.
- 3. Students are not permitted to wander around the building. Any student found in a restricted area will be subject to disciplinary action. This behavior could result in a suspension from school.
- 4. There will be no cell phones (or any electronic devices) used in the hallways or classrooms. If staff confiscates a phone (or any electronic devices) it will be returned at the end of class that day.
- 5. Students will wear regular school uniforms.
- 6. Violators of the above policies will be removed from the program. This can occur at any time and all disciplinary action is at the discretion of the Administration.
